County Recorder: R.C. 111.431(B) requires a county recorder who receives a properly completed *Real Property Confidentiality Notice* from a Safe at Home participant to promptly transmit a copy of this notice to the Ohio Secretary of State's Office, county auditor, county treasurer, and county engineer. County recorders should transmit copies via certified mail.

Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas: R.C. 111.431(C)(2) requires a clerk of court of common pleas to notify the Ohio Secretary of State's Office when a Safe at Home participant provides a *Real Property Confidentiality Notice*. County clerks should notify the Ohio Secretary of State's Office via certified mail.
